As a grassroots-level, non-profit organization, Ladli Foundation is known for implementing highly impactful and innovative social initiatives to uplift vulnerable people in urban and rural slums.

Ladli is involved in enhancing the standards of living and restoring the dignity of socially victimized women. From its initial years till date, it has directly benefited 75000+ unprivileged females and sensitized more than 5 Lacs people through its successfully implemented projects at the ground level.

India has an estimated 46 million children aged 6 to 18 who are forced into begging and labouring, and become victims of sexual abuse.

Ladli foundation through its unique mobile classes has provided free primary education to 2000 + young recipients in red light crossings and rural-urban slums, and simultaneously sensitized their parents about physical-mental health issues and crimes against children.

"E-PATHANSHALA"

Ladli has enabled access to digital education to 5000 + underprivileged kids through free, refurbished digital devices with loaded e-learning content and 3-years BYJU's premium subscription, for their secondary education and JEE/NEET preparation.

On 131st Birth Anniversary of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, 75 SC/ST kids were also provided the digital education kit.

In collaboration with Delhi police, juveniles and unemployed youths living in slums and lowcost areas were extricated from substance abuse, crimes and anti-social activities.

Around 1057 young at-risk juveniles were diverted through engagement in motivational, counselling and physical fitness activities including sports, dance, and yoga; and enrollment in YUVA skill training course.

100% job placements was provided to beneficiaries, and 80% reduced crime and substance abuse rate was achieved.

"DRUG PREVENTION AWARENESS"

With the National Institute of Social Defense (NISD), Ladli has organized a one-day community counselling and awareness programme in 20 locations, as a part of the National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR).

Through films, presentation modules, and interactive sessions, 1343 beneficiaries from diverse community were educated and sensitized about drug abuse, their negative effects and prevention.

In collaboration with AIIMS Rishikesh Doctors, Ladli has conducted a long webinar series to provide and distribute authentic information about COVID-19 to beneficiaries.

Out of 29 sessions, a few were specially conducted for females by women's health specialty doctors.

More than 593 questions were answered and around 8.5 Lacs people were impacted.

During third COVID wave, Ladli has initiated a certified frontline medical and first aid service at targeted locations to effectively handle unwanted emergencies.

15 Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) were stationed and 4 special Covid Quick Reaction Team (QRT) were formed with police personnel and 30 trained Yuva Covid warriors to provide first aid medical assistance and CPR, along with operation of oxygen concentrators.

YUVAs were compensated with regular honorarium of Rs. 15000/month for 6 months.



With support of Delhi State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited, New Delhi's Parvatiya slum dwellers were enrolled in a comprehensive community development programme composed of free health-checkups or CBC tests, nutritional intervention with anemia eradication kits, education, handholding welfare support, and YUVA skill training program.

Around 312 women beneficiaries benefitted from level of awareness on Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM), WASH, crime and drug prevention, digital literacy, and gender-related issues.


